

Who Qualifies for an NHS Subsidy or Sight Test?

- Children under 16 and Full time Students under 19.
- Those receiving income related benefits, i.e. Income Support, Tax Credit, JSA, ESA and Pension Credit Guarantee credit..
- Those holding an HC2 certificate.
- Those over 60.
- People with Diabetes or Glaucoma.
- Those over 40 with immediate family history of, or those assessed at risk of Glaucoma.
- Those registered Blind or Partially Sighted.
- Those prescribed complex lenses.
- Prisoners on leave.

Gold *Plus* is a Gold examination with additional tests and scans specifically designed to help rule out Glaucoma for those at risk. Any of these tests may also be recommended as a top up to other examinations at extra charge.
